Footnotes

DIXIE DAHLIN, outrun early, settled in behind foes, circled horses eight wide entering the stretch and was all out to be along in time. QUADERNA, well placed always and four or five wide, battled with the winner through deep stretch and was outfinished. OELECTRA gained a slight edge early while three or four wide, held the advantage into deep stretch and grudgingly weakened. MY OLD MAN'S MONEY, outrun for a half, moved within easy striking distance five or six wide into the final furlong and lacked a further response. TOUCH OF FIRE, in hand while following the leaders into the final furlong while four or five wide, flattened out when the test came. WRAPPER attended the pace inside to the stretch and faltered. SEA WEDDING, well placed five wide to the stretch, weakened thereafter. REPOSE, reluctant to load into the gate, raced evenly. STAR IN THE CORNER never reached serious contention. STORY'S IMAGE was outrun. WINTERS BLAST, unruly behind the gate prior to the start, was done early. MISS BETTY JO gave way after a half. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
