STAKES Kentucky Cup Turf Dash S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. FREE NOMINATION. \$250 to enter and an additional \$250 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 16, 2009 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-year-olds, 119 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf in 2009, allowed 2 lbs.; \$37,500 twice on the turf since May 15, 4 lbs.; \$25,000 twice on the turf in 2008-2009, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at the time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2009. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed September 12, 2009 with 36 nominations.

Footnotes

FORT PRADO settled in hand off of the inside, advanced from between horses through the turn, got through in the final furlong, finished with a surge and was up in the final strides. YANKEE INJUNUITY was away alertly and angled in to save ground down the hill, drew even leaving the turn, battled gamely from between horses through a prolonged drive but was denied in the shadow of the wire. HOLD THE SALT steadied from tight quarters off of the hill, recovered quickly and ranged up four wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, kept on well but wasn't quite good enough. VEILED PROPHET was unhurried into stride, closed the gap through the turn, offered a mild bid along the inside nearing the furlong marker but lacked the needed late response. POWER SURGE checked sharply from between horses coming off of the hill early, came five wide and finished with some late run but failed to seriously threaten. NO FAULT rushed to contention five wide but faltered during the drive and faded. HURRY HOME WARREN settled in the second flight off of the inside and failed to respond. JUST FOR KEEPS pulled clear to set the pace, but was headed after a half and gave way readily thereafter. EXTRICATION was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and dropped out.
