STAKES Kentucky Cup Turf S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. FREE NOMINATION. \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 16, 2009 by payment of \$7,500 each (includes all fees). \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-Year-Olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice over ten furlongs on the turf since September 13, 2008 allowed 2, lbs.; \$40,000 twice over a mile on the turf since April 6, allowed 4, lbs.; \$30,000 over a mile on the turf in 2009, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entrybox by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2009. Failure to draw into race cancels all fees. Closed September 12, 2009 with 25 nominations.

CLOUDY'S KNIGHT settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, shifted out entering the stretch to find room, split rivals and forged command with three-sixteenths to run, opened clear and maintained a safe advantage. REZIF was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, split horses leaving the second turn, got through and finished full of run but was unable to reach the winner. SILVER MOUNTAIN was allowed to settle, moved with the winner through the second turn, came four wide and loomed a danger but lacked the needed late punch. DEAL MAKING was unhurried into stride, came four wide to make a late rally and improved his position through the stretch. SOUTHWEST was hustled along to attend the pace three wide, offered a mild bid four wide but failed to sustain the drive. INDEPENDENT GEORGE was forwardly placed three wide to the stretch and tired. RUMOR HAS IT set the pace well off of the inside, was headed after six furlongs, angled in on the second turn and was within contention to the stretch but dropped out. GUADALCANAL prompted the pace along the inside, assumed command off of the hill on the backstretch, opened clear through the second turn, but came up empty in the drive and retreated. MY HAPPINESS (ARG) was close up along the inside early, dropped back up the hill on the backstretch, made a belated gain from between horses with a quarter to run but failed to menace. ROGUE VICTORY failed to respond.
