ART VARIETY (BRZ), reserved near the inside soon after the start, went along under careful handling, continued inside while advancing into the stretch, battled on even terms with QUEST STAR, then, while drifting out in the final yards and bumping with that one, prevailed under pressure. ROCHESTER, never far back, raced in behind horses early, rallied five or six wide into to the stretch, loomed menacingly through the drive and wasn't quite good enough when bumped approaching the wire by QUEST STAR when that one was forced out by ART VARIETY (BRZ). QUEST STAR, rated along the inside early, edged closer upon going a mile, moved boldly five wide nearing the stretch, gained a slim lead, was joined from the inside by ART VARIETY (BRZ) in the upper stretch and wasn't good enough at the end when bumped by ART VARIETY (BRZ) in the final yards and forced out on ROCHESTER. ACT OF WAR, within easy striking distance, made a run between foes four or five wide into the final furlong and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. CETEWAYO, in a striking position five or six wide much of the way, lacked a final response. CONTINENTAL RED, well placed to the stretch, was empty in the drive. KIM LOVES BUCKY never threatened. BONUS PACK gained the lead early, raced five wide, drew off after six furlongs, made the pace until approaching the stretch and tired. THE RIDERS OF ROCHESTER AND QUEST STAR LODGED FOUL CLAIMS AGAINST ART VARIETY (BRZ) FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE NEARING THE WIRE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW OF THE VIDEO TAPE REPLAYS, STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED ART VARIETY (BRZ) AND PLACED HIM THIRD. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED. MISSING FRACTIONAL TIME WAS UNAVAILABLE.
