NITA WINS TOO settled in behind rivals early, split foes three wide entering the stretch, angled to the rail when straightened for the drive and was ridden hard to prevail. MARNIE'S HEIRLOOM, never far back and four or five wide, was with the winner on even terms in the late going and wasn't good enough. SAPPHIRE HILL, well placed always, was six wide on even terms for the lead in the final furlong and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. MAID OF HONOR, outrun to the stretch, was going well at the end while six wide. DARBY'S CHARM gained the lead early, raced three wide, battled forwardly into the final furlong and weakened. KISSINLEAF, outrun for a half, reached contention in the upper stretch and failed to continue. UNZIPPER failed to menace. SMOOTH IMAGE raced forwardly to the stretch and tired. KISSASSTAR was done early. ONE MORE MOONDANCE tired upon going a half. LUHAN forced the pace for a half and gave way nearing the stretch. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
