JAKE THE FLAKE, outrun for a half, reached contention concluding the turn while four or five wide, continued off the inside and closed determinedly under strong handling to prevail. GLICK, never far back while in behind front-running PYRUS, moved out three or four wide to go after that one entering the stretch, took over, briefly was clear, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. PYRUS sprinted clear on the backstretch, made the pace three wide, showed the way into the lane and weakened. ROYAL SPY, within easy striking distance throughout while outside the leaders, was empty in the drive. CATNIRO settled early, moved inside and failed to rally. JADADA raced in contention until midway on the turn, held his position but couldn't threaten in the stretch run. VEGETARIAN was outrun. GOLDEN OLDIE tired upon going a half and was five wide into the stretch. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
