Footnotes

ROCHESTER, unhurried early, raced in hand within easy striking distance, moved three or four wide into the stretch, took over approaching the eighth pole and was under brisk urging the remainder. NOWRASS (GB), also within striking distance, moved with the winner into the stretch but couldn't keep pace as second best. CONTINENTAL RED, nicely placed early while tracking the pace four wide, loomed a solid threat from between foes for the last eighth but came up empty. CETEWAYO, outrun until the stretch, improved position but couldn't challenge. DEPUTY STRIKE, outrun to the stretch, never reached contention while improving position. RED MOUNTAIN, outrun to the stretch, passed tired rivals. RIDDLESDOWN (IRE) gained the lead soon after the start, worked his way inward, went along under careful handling, made the pace into the stretch and had little left at the end. GRAMMARIAN chased front-running RIDDLESDOWN (IRE) while four wide to the stretch and weakened thereafter. HOMELAND (FR) raced in a striking position five wide into the stretch and tired. DEVIL TIME faded approaching the stretch. CHESHIRE (GB), never far back during the early stages, moved out five wide on the backstretch, continued in a striking position to the stretch and gave way. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED. THE QUARTER-MILE SPLIT WAS UNAVAILABLE.
