Footnotes

RED LIGHTNING, outrun early, moved four or five wide approaching the stretch, reached the front at the furlong grounds and was kept to his task to draw clear. ALOHA BOLD, unhurried early, raced in behind the leaders, saved ground into the final furlong, angled four or five wide to move with the winner while inside that one and wasn't a match late. MIGHTY BEAU tracked the pace four wide into the lane, gained about even terms at the furlong grounds but flattened out. BROWN EYED MAJOR, outrun for a half, circled foes eight wide into the stretch and offered a minor gain while unable to menace. DIAMANT (ARG), within striking distance, lacked a closing account. SUPREMO SECRET pressed front-running DANCING MISSILE to the stretch and tired. HONOR ME settled in behind the leaders early, raced within easy striking distance, swung out five wide at the quarter-mile ground but faltered in the drive. DANCING MISSILE gained the lead inside early, made the pace into the stretch and tired. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
