FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Thursday, September 19, 2002 by payment of \$5,000 each.

Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf in 2002 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since April 21 allowed 5 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2002 allowed 7 lbs.turf. Preference to start will be given to those nominees that are Graded or Group stakes winners. Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2002. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. All supplementary nominees will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Closed Thursday, September 12, 2002.

SAN DARE, unhurried early while racing in behind the leaders, angled out for the drive and drove clear late. DOUBLY FUN forced the pace from early on while four wide, reached the front nearing the final quarter, made the pace into deep stretch and couldn't handle the winner's surge. SLUICE, never far back, improved position in the late stages but couldn't challenge the top two. LITTLERIVERQUEEN, outrun to the stretch, also improved position while passing tired foes. CURIOUS CONUNDRUM, well placed into the stretch while near the inside, came up empty. BAIL MONEY, outrun to the stretch, offered a mild gain. LA RECHERCHE gained a slim lead early while maneuvering near the inside, contested the issue into the stretch and weakened. PERSIAN SILVER broke through the gate prior to the start. After being reloaded, PERSIAN SILVER vied for the lead inside for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. SOLVIG raced in a striking position to the stretch and tired. FOUR PLUS FOUR well placed outside rivals to the stretch, faltered in the drive. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
