### Footnotes

KERA'S KITTEN broke sharply to set the pressured pace, shook clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. POSITIVE SPLIT broke a step slow, angled in to save ground, split horses entering the stretch to launch a bold bid, but was unable to reach the winner. L J'S WAY attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. BASCOM HALL was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a late rally and improved his position. ANGEL'S CAN BOOGIE pressed the pace three wide, weakened from between horses in the drive and gave way. PRONTO CABALLO chased the pace four wide for five furlongs and flattened. U HUSH broke slow and was never a factor. GUNMAN was slow into stride, dropped well behind his field and never recovered.
