STAKES Kentucky Cup Ladies Turf S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 19, 2007 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-year-olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2007, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since April 23, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2007, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2007. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 15 with 24 nominations.

QUIET ROYAL, in hand early and racing near the inside, continued from the rail when rallying into the lane and was hard ridden to wear down RICH FANTASY in the late going. RICH FANTASY gained the advantage three wide, managed a slight advantage into the final furlong and couldn't contain the winner in the late going while out-gaming CAMELA CARSON for the place. CAMELA CARSON tracked front-running RICH FANTASY from the outset four wide, loomed boldly in the drive and wasn't good enough. ROYAL PLEASURE, never far back while in behind horses, couldn't muster a final response. KISS WITH A TWIST, outrun to the lane, made a run off the inside into the last eighth but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. ROYAL REGAN stalked the pace five wide into the upper stretch and came up empty. WATER GAP lacked a serious late bid. BEST MOM raced within easy striking distance to the upper stretch and tired. EL BANK ROBBER raced in contention to the stretch and flattened out. LERICI tired on the far turn. STRONG VOWS was outrun. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
