

KENTUCKY DOWNS - September 22, 2007 - Race 14

STAKES Kentucky Cup Turf S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200, \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start.

Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 19, 2007 by payment of \$10,000 each (includes all fees). \$200,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth.

Three-Year-Olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice over ten furlongs on the turf since September 23, 2006 allowed 2, lbs.; \$40,000 twice over a mile on the turf since April 8, allowed 4, lbs.; \$30,000 over a mile on the turf in 2007, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2007. Failure to draw into race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 15 with 25 nominations.

Footnotes

GENERAL JUMBO (GB), in hand early, commenced a steady advance four wide on the far turn, reached the front nearing the final furlong and was hard ridden the remainder to best FRI GUY safe in course record time. FRI GUY went up early to press front-running STARSPANGLED GATOR, inched closer on the far turn, poked his head in front between calls in the upper stretch, then couldn't contain the winner in the late going while easily second best. GOLDEN STRATEGY, nicely positioned in behind the leaders from early on, was never far back, maneuvered four wide for the drive but couldn't muster the needed late gain. DEMETEOR, within striking distance and in behind horses, worked his way out five wide for the drive and improved position late while not a serious threat. DAN MCGREW eased off the inside, made a mild run five wide on the far turn and failed to continue. STARSPANGLED GATOR gained the lead near the inside, was clear early, showed the way to the head of the stretch and faltered. LORD CARMEN never menaced. YATE'S BLACK CAT tired approaching the stretch. THE QUARTER-MILE FRACTION WAS UNAVAILABLE. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
