STAKES Kentucky Cup Turf Dash S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 19, 2007 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-year-olds, 119 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf in 2007, allowed 2 lbs.; \$37,500 twice on the turf since May 15, 4 lbs.; \$25,000 twice on the turf in 2006-2007, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at the time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2007. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 15 with 19 nominations.

HOLD THE SALT gained the advantage from between foes early, edged clear on the turn while three wide, made the balance of the pace and was kept to his task in the drive to prevail in course record time. SHARK chased the winner from early on four wide, had aim in the stretch but wasn't a threat at the end while superior to the others. ECCLESIASTIC, outsprinted early, raced five wide into the final furlong and bested the others. RAEDONALD, within striking distance and near the inside to the lane, was empty when the test came. COUGAR CAT, well placed four or five wide into the final furlong, flattened out thereafter. ACTUAL had no rally. RIDGE RUNNER (GB) wasn't a factor. ATTICUS KRISTY weakened upon going a half. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
