FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. FREE NOMINATION. Closes Saturday, September 13, 2008.

Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Thursday, September 18, 2008 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$500 to enter and start. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-year-olds 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over on the turf since March 15, allowed 3 lbs.; \$25,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2008 allowed 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start by condition eligibility. In addition, no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 13, 2008 with 65 nominations.

Footnotes

MY BABY BABY settled in hand on the outside, came four wide to make her bid, reeled in the leaders inside the furlong marker and was inching away late. THE REAL FUTURE stalked the pace along the inside, shifted to the outside to launch her bid leaving the turn, forged a narrow lead nearing the furlong marker, battled gamely but was unable to resist the winner. TREMENDOUS ONE settled between horses three wide, angled out to find room entering the stretch, finished full of run and was gaining on the top two with every stride. ASPIRING pressed the pace three wide, poked her head in front entering the stretch, but weakened slightly during the drive and grudgingly gave way. BALLADO'S THUNDER set the pressured pace between horses on the backstretch, then along the inside through the turn but flattened out during the drive and faded. SHARBAT was unhurried into stride, came four wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. MONTE CRYSTAL (PER) settled in the second flight three wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. C B T SNAKEYE pressed the pace along the inside but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. GREEN DOOR saved ground to no avail. PUT AWAY THE HALO broke awkwardly, rushed to contention four wide, stopped before going a half, was eased to the wire but walked off.
