ROCKIN' JOE settled saving ground, angled out leaving the turn to launch his bid five wide, lugged in entering the stretch, was quickly straightened away, forged command inside the furlong marker and was all out to keep the fast closing PRESENTS FOR BERTI at bay. PRESENTS FOR BERTI settled into stride and angled in to save ground, got through to make his bid entering the stretch, drifted out a bit through the drive to be clear, closed with a rush and was getting to the winner with every stride. AMBRAW stalked the pace along the inside, shifted three wide leaving the turn, forged a narrow lead nearing the furlong marker, continued on willingly but grudgingly gave way in the final yards. LAST MARTINI attended the pace three wide between horses, finished with some late run but failed to seriously threaten. CLASSIC BRIDGES made a middle move four wide to vie for the lead leaving the turn, but weakened during the drive and faded. MISTER JO JANGLES opened clear to set the pace through the turn and tired. DAYS ACTION was forwardly placed between horses for six furlongs and dropped out. FIRST ACTION HERO was bumped at the start and awkward into stride and showed little thereafter. REDGRAVE broke slowly, dropped well back and trailed throughout.
