

WORD PUZZLE gained the lead early, raced three or four wide, shook off a challenge from AMARETTA on the turn, then proved gamely best under strong handling. ROSA'S DELAWARE, never far back while in behind foes, split rivals four or five wide in the final furlong and earned the place. MAY GATOR, always well placed, loomed prominently outside the winner four or five wide into the final furlong but came up empty. SYMPHONIC LADY, outrun to the stretch, offered a mild gain. PEACE KEEPING (IRE) stalked the pace five wide into the final furlong, was within easy striking distance but flattened out. LOTTA RHYTHM, never far back and five wide early, moved inside while making a run into the final furlong but failed to continue. AMARETTA, close up inside the winner early, eased outside that one on the turn to challenge but faltered in the drive. TEMIS (CHI) wasn't a factor. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
