JUSTAKISS, well placed from early on while lightly rated four wide, advanced to the fore from between foes entering the upper stretch, edged clear, then held sway under urging. DOWN TO THE LINT, never far back, ranged up outside the winner six wide for the drive but wasn't good enough. PRECOCIOUS, within easy striking distance and four or five wide, was empty late. LIVELY CLASSIC, outrun for a half, improved position but wasn't a serious threat. SOUNDLESS had no rally. CAYENNE BLUSH gained the lead from between foes early, raced three or four wide, made the pace into the stretch and tired. WHATASHAMEMARYJANE forced the pace five wide to the stretch, was on even terms when straightened for the drive but flattened out. HUMOR HER never was prominent. SENSE OF TIME, reluctant to load into the gate, was briefly in front after the start and faded upon leaving the backstretch. CLEVER US showed nothing. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
