

**KENTUCKY DOWNS - September 26, 2006 - Race 3**

STAKES Kentucky Cup Ladies Turf S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 20, 2006 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed of which all monies to be divided \$62,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Three-year-olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2006, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf since April 23, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2006, 6 lbs. Starters must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at the time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2006. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 16, 2006 with 37 nominations.

DASH OF HUMOR settled in behind the leaders early, rallied from the rail, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and was hard ridden the remainder. HONEY ROSE (ARG) gained a clear lead early, edged in three wide, made the pace under light rating, lost the edge to the winner a sixteenth out and held on stubbornly the remainder. VICTORY LAP, outrun early, advanced six wide into the lane and couldn't offer the needed late gain. DYNAMIST, outrun into the stretch, offered a mild late gain. THETACTICS OFDANCE had no rally. MISS WELLSRING pressed front-running HONEY ROSE (ARG) into the final furlong and weakened. ALMOST INNOCENT (IRE) stalked the pace to the stretch four wide and tired. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
