

**KENTUCKY DOWNS - September 26, 2006 - Race 4**

STAKES Kentucky Cup Turf S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200, \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry on Wednesday, September 20, 2006 by payment of \$10,000 each (includes all fees). \$200,000 Guaranteed of which all monies to be divided \$124,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Three-Year-Olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice over ten furlongs on the turf since September 24, 2005 allowed 2, lbs.; \$40,000 twice over a mile on the turf since April 8, allowed 4, lbs.; \$30,000 over a mile on the turf in 2006, 6 lbs. Starters must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. In the event more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Graded or Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2006. Failure to draw into race cancels all fees. Closed Saturday, September 16, 2006 with 20 nominations.

**Footnotes**

EMBOSSSED (IRE), well in hand while tracking the pace from the start four wide, went up entering the backstretch to force the issue while outside of CAUSEWAY, took over from that one entering the upper stretch, then managed a narrow advantage the remainder under strong handling to gamely prevail. LORD CARMEN, under rating while tracking the dueling leaders, raced four or five wide, battled on even terms with the winner while outside that one through much of the stretch and was outfinished. ROCHESTER, unhurried and near the inside, raced in behind horses to the stretch, worked his way out four or five wide, made a bold run into the final furlong but wasn't quite good enough. DYNALYPIC, always well placed, loomed prominently through the drive but was empty when the test came. SILVERFOOT, within striking distance although fractions were modest, raced six or seven wide into the last eighth and lacked a response. ROCK LOBSTER broke awkwardly, was steadied and lacked a serious rally. CAUSEWAY gained a clear advantage near the inside upon going a quarter, raced under light restraint, was joined soon after by the winner from the outside, battled with EMBOSSSED (IRE) to the stretch and weakened thereafter. MAJOR RHYTHM tired after a mile. ALL RACES AT KENTUCKY DOWNS ARE HAND TIMED.
