FOREIGN EXCHANGE settled saving ground, closed the gap through the turn, shifted out and split horses to continue the drive, and edged clear despite lugging in through the drive. PRETTY DRINK opened clear to set the pace, was unable to resist the winner following a long drive, but kept on well to hold the place. MISTER MONSIEUR was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a late rally, lugged in entering the stretch, steadied off heels with a furlong to run, came again from between rivals and was just up to earn the show. ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR was slow into stride, made a mild bid circling five wide but weakened during the drive. THE LIONS TRICK tracked the pace two wide, angled in entering the stretch to make his bid but failed to sustain the drive. TEETEE'S TAPIT settled in the second flight, made a mild rally from between horses but failed to threaten. TALK TO NICK chased the pace three wide to the final furlong and faltered. HAITIAN HERO passed only his tiring rivals. RIDETHEHIGHCOUNTRY was never a factor. LARRY APPEL showed little. EXPLICIT ORDERS was through early.
