LIL'S LAD set the pace inside and drew off in the drive under a steady hand ride. POWERFUL GOER, within striking distance inside, lacked a late bid but held the place. CRIMSON CLASSIC, within striking distance, raced five wide into the turn then improved his position on the outside. CALCA, outrun early, was inside with three furlongs to go and had nothing left late. SLICK REPORT, within striking distance off the inside, tired in the stretch. SILVER LAUNCH, unhurried early, saved ground on the turn and was no threat. EXTROVERT was outrun. COPELAN TOO lost his footing at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, moved four wide into the turn and tired. POLE E STYLE forced the pace off the inside, stayed well for a half and stopped. DIX CARAT D'OR, close up early, stayed well to midway through the turn and faded.
