HECTOR stumbled at the start and ducked out bumping with SASHA'S PROSPECT, quickly settled inside, raced under rating into the stretch, swung out deftly four wide approaching the furlong grounds, then prevailed under vigorous hand urging. ROLL LABEL went up soon after the start to force the pace three or four wide, reached the front in the upper stretch but couldn't handle HECTOR late. NO DICE, outrun until the stretch, made a mild gain. SASHA'S PROSPECT, bumped at the start, quickly recovered to the gain the lead, made the pace until the final furlong and faltered. ON THE TEE had no rally. TRULY TOPFLIGHT stalked the leaders four or five wide, held on well into the stretch and tired. MEDIEVIL HERO was used up early. WOODY BE GOOD, in behind the leaders early, came out five wide while in contention nearing the stretch but tired soon after. WIRED was outrun and six wide in the stretch.
