STAKES Ashland S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

For Fillies Three Years Old. By subscription of \$250 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$5,000 to enter and start with \$500,000 added, of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs., \$60,000 at a mile or over 5 lbs., \$30,000 twice at any distance 8 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Ashland will be limited to fourteen. Same owner entry cannot start to the exclusion of a single entry. Starters to be named through the entry box the usual time of closing.

SILVERBULLETDAY, was reserved just off the early leaders, angled three wide entering the backstretch, moved to challenge once ready on the second turn, collared MARLEY VALE when straightening into the stretch, then widened under a hand ride. The latter sprinted clear at once, maintained the advantage under good handling, then hung on well after being displaced by the winner to be clearly second best. GOLD FROM THE WEST prompted the pace from the outset, offered a bid late on the second turn, but could not keep pace late. WALTZ ON BY trailed for a half while saving ground, then passed tiring rivals. TOUT CHARMANT, forwardly placed four wide down the backstretch, failed to reach contention. HERE I GO raced five wide on the backstretch and showed little.
