HEART OF A KING pulled to the lead four wide, opened clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. PLATINUM VAN was unhurried into stride, angled out and split horses six wide leaving the turn, finished full of run and was making up ground readily. BROTHER KEITH attended the pace toward the inside, shifted out three wide to make his bid, and was along in time to earn the show. FINAL JUDGEMENT prompted the pace between horses, but weakened during the drive and gave way. COACH GRAVY contended between horses, offered a mild bid entering the lane but flattened out in the final furlong. MAP OF THE WORLD was unhurried and angled in to save ground, closed the gap through the turn, angled out entering the stretch, was caught in tight and steadied with a furlong to run losing his best chance. DOC'S FRIEND rushed up between horses to vie for the lead, but came up empty leaving the bend and faded. STRATOS saved ground to no avail. CHECKSANDBALANCES disputed the pace along the inside for a half and gave way. WILDCAT BRIEF was forwardly placed five wide for a half and dropped out. AFRICAN DIAMOND was allowed to settle, made a mild rally five wide, steadied near the quarter pole and showed little thereafter. SUNDAYS BABY GRAND raced wide throughout and showed little.
