MAESTRO MISS outrun for a half, advanced four wide on the second turn, challenged in midstretch and proved narrowly best. HOME FRIES within striking distance off the rail, moved out three wide leaving the second turn, leaned in in an attempt to maintain her position in upper stretch bumping with GREAT INSPIRATION, battled with the winner and TRIBECKY through the final furlong while between that pair and just missed. TRIBECKY set the pace off the inside, responded when headed before a half, came again on the second turn to gain a short lead, expanded that lead a bit once in the stretch, was engaged by the top pair near the furlong marker and held on gamely while not quite good enough. CITY WAY reserved off the inside, made a run five wide out of the second turn, reached a forward position with a furlong to go but lacked a solid closing bid. LEDA reserved early, advanced inside late on the second turn, steadied behind a wall of horses in upper stretch, angled out for a clear path but had no late bid. HOLY MOMENT reserved early, waited while saving ground with three furlongs to go, clipped heels in traffic once in the stretch then had no late response. AMAZING SAINT closest to the pace three wide, tired. GREAT INSPIRATION forwardly placed four wide, gained a short lead before a half, battled to the stretch, steadied and bumped with HOME FRIES in upper stretch when attempting to maintain her position then faded. FILLAZZENE within striking distance three wide, faded. WALKURE was outrun. THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY.
