HOOH WHY sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace while kept off the rail, drew clear into the stretch and lasted late. GOZZIP GIRL stumbled after the start, recovered to race within striking distance four wide, advanced in that path late on the second turn and rallied willingly to miss. STARDOM BOUND unhurried for a half while outrun, moved up slowly four wide on the second turn but lodged only a mild late bid. BE FAIR angled out in the run to the first turn, prompted the winner while outside that one but weakened late. NAN within striking distance off the rail, maintained good position to the stretch and tired. BOLEYN forwardly placed from the start, raced in the four path with a quarter mile to go and tired. DREAM EMPRESS outrun early, made a mild move off the rail after five furlongs but had no late bid. THIRD DAWN unprepared for the start, recovered to race within striking distance, moved out four wide approaching the stretch and tired. WHAT A PEAR close up early along the inside, faded in the drive.
