Footnotes

MALIZIOSA, unhurried early while lightly rated five wide, came out a bit farther on the course entering the stretch, wrested command when straightened for the drive, then was kept to her task. FAREWELL MY LOVELY settled in behind horses early, saved ground for six furlongs, came out five wide on the far turn to advance, moved eight abreast in the stretch and finished willingly. WOODSIA, within striking distance while racing between foes three or four wide much of the trip, improved position at the end but wasn't a serious threat. GLORIOSITY was hustled after the start to vie for the lead outside of TOP THE SKY, alternated for the lead with that one until the stretch and weakened in the drive. CADILLAC MOUNTAIN moved inside early, saved ground into the stretch, angled out five or six wide at the sixteenth pole but couldn't threaten. JUST KISS ME QUICK settled three or four wide, moved after the dueling leaders nearing the stretch, gained even terms a quarter-mile out but flattened out in the drive. SPUR CREEK, well placed in behind horses until the stretch, weakened thereafter. TAP THE SKY contested the pace inside of GLORIOSITY until the stretch and tired. BROTHER'S BLUFF broke slowly and never was close.
