Footnotes

FLY BORBOLETA, well placed inside from early on, eased out four wide on the backstretch to inch after front-running UNSURPASSED, reached the front just before going six furlongs, then increased her advantage in the drive under mild hand encouragement. UNSURPASSED gained the lead early, drew clear on the first turn, made the pace for almost six furlongs, surrendered the advantage to the winner, then continued on as second best. OUR MAJESTIC CAT settled early while three or four wide, continued in that manner to made a mild run into the upper stretch but couldn't make up the difference. MIU MIU, outrun for six furlongs, raced four wide into the stretch, reached contention at the eighth pole but lacked a further account. SALZURITA (ARG), forwardly placed inside early, raced between rivals while remaining in contention three wide to the stretch and weakened. RUN RATE, unhurried inside early, swung out six or seven wide for the stretch run but failed to rally. CHAP UP chased the leaders from between rivals four wide for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. AFRICAN SKYLINE drifted out at the start, quickly recovered, raced in contention for three-quarters while four or five wide and tired.
