**Footnotes**

ELECTRICITY, under light rating from early on while following the leaders five or six wide, angled wider on the course for the drive and was all out to capture a close decision. COBRADOR, up close along the inside from the outset, gained the edge on the backstretch while dueling, opened a clear advantage in the upper stretch and couldn't contain the winner's surge while drifting out slightly at the end. LE DAUPHIN, always well placed and near the inside, eased out a bit for the drive and couldn't get up. WINEMASTER, unhurried while racing in behind horses, continued from the rail to rally boldly in the final sixteenth and was going well at the end. COMMODORE BOB went up to vie for the lead early while between foes, continued forwardly into the final furlong and couldn't continue. EXTON, never far back, raced within easy striking distance while between foes into the final furlong and lacked the needed response. DON'TWAIT TOOLONG, unhurried early, reached contention six or seven wide entering the upper stretch but failed to fire. AMWAAL had no rally. HOLIDAY TRIP weakened on the far turn. CAPTAIN CUGAT gained a slim lead while dueling to the head of the stretch and weakened.

BROGANVILLE never menaced. WARN was outrun.
