Footnotes

GASCONADE settled in hand toward the inside, waited in traffic with seven-sixteenths to run, advanced swiftly from between horses through the turn, angled out five wide into the lane, wore down SUPER NEKIA and was inching away late. SUPER NEKIA vied for the lead four wide, assumed a narrow lead nearing the furlong marker, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner in the final yards. HYRULE was jostled between horses at the start, settled between horses in mid pack, launched his bid six wide leaving the turn and was up in time to earn the show. SKIM SCAM broke in the air to get away behind his field, settled saving ground, closed the gap through the turn, split horses entering the stretch and improved his position. FAR EAST GOLD was away alertly and dueled for the lead removed from the rail, but weakened during the drive and gave way. MESA GOLD failed to respond. BRIGHTEST HOPE contended between horses early, drifted out entering the turn, raced wide thereafter and dropped back. IT'S A RAP was hustled along near the back of the pack five wide, angled in entering the stretch and passed his tiring rivals. EMBARRASSED saved ground to no avail. CLASSY WONDER prompted the pace between horses, steadied with seven-sixteenths to run and dropped off of the pace, kept on fairly well to the final furlong and tired. FLY TRUE was always outrun.
