**Footnotes**

I'LL CALL attended the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the second turn, caught the leaders inside the furlong marker and edged clear. WIND OF BOSPHORUS opened clear and angled in to dispute the pace, fought on through a prolonged drive but was unable to match strides with the winner late. KITON pulled to contention along the inside, was wrestled off of the pace and shifted to the outside of WIND OF BOSPHORUS on the backstretch, moved up to engage again after a half, but weakened in the final furlong and settled for the show. PARNELLI broke awkwardly, settled between horses, angled in on the second turn, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. TORMENTA FIERA was rank to place, leveled into stride between horses, came four wide and was making up ground. JAZIL BELL was close up four wide through the second turn and faded. TIZ NOW MY CHOICE failed to respond. TACTICAL MOMENT was hung wide and was never a factor. RAKETE showed little. EQUUS PRIME settled saving ground, bled and stopped after a half.
