Footnotes

NO DEADLINE gained a slim lead inside early while dueling with KERNITRE (GB), shook off that one on the far turn, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage, then was kept to her task to widen. LOVELY LADY angled inside behind horses early, saved ground for six furlongs, came out four wide entering the stretch, was just off the winner for the last eighth but couldn't threaten as second best. FAR SIGHTED SAL, bumped at the start, was taken in hand and maneuvered inside, rallied between foes on the far turn, came out six wide for the drive and improved position. CASUAL FEAT stalked the pace three or four wide, loomed prominently into the stretch but came up empty. LITTLERIVERQUEEN moved inside on the backstretch, remained along the inside into the stretch but failed to rally. MARIAWORTH vied for the lead early while three abreast, fell back last on the backstretch, then passed tired ones in the drive. JESTER, five or six wide much of the way, failed to threaten. KERNITRE (GB) battled for the lead outside the winner for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. VAUXHALL drifted out at the start bumping FAR SIGHTED SAL, worked her way inside, raced four wide around the far turn and tired. MARILYN MERLOT, in contention for six furlongs while four or five wide, faded. The finish margins were determined by the Equibase staff after the photo-finish camera malfunctioned.
