### Footnotes

POSSE drifted in slightly at the start, settled in behind foes, came out four wide while entering the upper stretch, reached the front leaving the furlong grounds and drove clear under mild hand urging. ROLL HENNESSY ROLL stalked the pace early while four wide, gained a brief, slim lead in the upper stretch, then wasn't a match for POSSE in the final furlong. BOSSANOVA gained the lead at the start, worked his way inward, made the pace two or three wide into the upper stretch and weakened. WHYWHYWHY broke in the air to trail, raced near the inside to the stretch, came out to make a mild run three or four wide approaching the final furlong but couldn't continue. BATTLE WON drifted in a bit at the break, moved up inside to force the pace, held on well until approaching the stretch and faltered. QUICK DRAW, four wide most of the way, tired upon going a half.
