RATHOR (IRE), reserved early, edged closer near the end of the backstretch while between foes, angled five wide into the stretch, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove clear under energetic hand urging. THRONG attended the pace early while inside of BETTER THAN BONDS, gained a slight edge in the upper stretch but wasn't a match for RATHOR (IRE) in the late going. BETTER THAN BONDS gained the advantage early while kept five wide, held on well into the upper stretch and weakened. STUDENT COUNCIL, within easy striking distance while rated along five wide, came out seven wide leaving the second turn and lacked a closing kick. CHESTERTOWN SLEW, well placed near the inside to the upper stretch, flattened out when the test came. IRENE'S MON raced near the inside from early on, maneuvered out four or five wide for the drive and never fired. FUNNY CIDE tracked the early pace four or five wide, moved wider on the backstretch, lost position and dropped back last between calls approaching the lane, then passed only tired rivals. SPELLBINDER, forwardly placed five wide early, fell back on the backstretch, angled inside and was finished. ZARABAD (IRE) hopped at the start, raced in behind foes, was asked for his best a quarter-mile out and failed to respond.
