Footnotes

KEEP LAUGHING tracked the pace four wide from early on, took over about the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to last over HATTA FORT (GB) while coming out slightly and brushing that one. HATTA FORT (GB), sluggish to start and unhurried three wide for a half, maneuvered out seven wide for the stretch run, had aim at the winner and couldn't get up while brushed by KEEP LAUGHING at the end. EATON'S GIFT moved to the front two or three wide, managed a clear lead into the final furlong and couldn't continue. KODIAK KOWBOY, within easy striking distance and three or four wide to the stretch, angled six wide for the drive and had no rally. LING LING QI chased front-running EATON'S GIFT four wide to the stretch and weakened. CUSH, near the inside, was asked for more a quarter-mile out and came up empty. CAPE OF STORMS raced four or five wide and tired leaving the turn.
