HOWE GREAT was reserved off of the pace three wide, moved up to engage AIR SUPPORT on the second turn, forged command with a furlong to run and held stubbornly through the drive. MIDDIE was unhurried into stride, settled toward the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, split rivals and was getting to the winner with every stride. AIR SUPPORT opened clear and angled in to set the pace, dug in to meet the challenge but grudgingly gave way following a prolonged drive. SKY BLAZER settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch and was making up ground between horses. AL KHALI contended four wide, but weakened between horses during the drive and faded. TURALLURE broke a step slow, moved up along the inside, was rank to place and checked repeatedly through the first turn, leveled into stride under a snug hold while within contention, but faltered entering the stretch and dropped out. FORTE DEI MARM (GB) was allowed to settle, tipped out five wide entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon.
