Footnotes

BYDEED ducked in at the start, was straightened, sprinted clear and to the inside set the pace while saving ground, drifted out in midstretch then lusted. SAILOR'S WARNING, closest to the pace off the inside, was angled in in midstretch and rallied willingly inside to miss. EARLY REPORT, forwardly placed inside, lacked a closing bid. KIPLING, within striking distance, raced three wide on the turn and tired in the drive. SNOQUALMIE, unhurried early inside, was no real threat. ELSARRAAF, within striking distance early, raced four wide on the turn and gave way in the stretch. VEGAS REBELS, never far back off the inside, faded in the stretch. LAC WOEBEGONE broke slowly and was outrun. NORTHERN DAZE, roughed at the start, was no factor. HARRIER was not a menace.
