**Footnotes**

TEACH appeared to jump a shadow on the track approaching the first turn, settled in hand to stalk front-running TWO DOT SLEW, moved steadily after that one from the outside approaching the stretch, took over and edged clear under energetic handling. TWO DOT SLEW moved to a clear, easy lead early, raced under a long rating hold, showed the way into the final furlong, couldn't handle TEACH but was superior to the others. STAR QUEEN, unhurried early, edged in on the backstretch, reached easy striking distance between foes nearing the stretch but was empty when straightened for the drive. STORM GALE, never far back while racing in behind the leaders, failed to muster a closing bid. BROADWAY EXPRESS, outrun to the far turn, made a mild bid to reach contention nearing the stretch but failed to continue. OATSEE, well placed from the start, moved off the inside entering the backstretch to follow the leaders four or five wide, held on well until nearing the stretch and tired. ROYAL NO TRUMP leaned in at the start exchanging bumps with CASSIA, tracked the leaders four or five wide to the end of the backstretch and weakened thereafter. ALYMARCHE was outrun. CASSIA came out at the start exchanging bumps with ROYAL NO TRUMP, showed speed for about a half and tired.
