Footnotes

FIERY DANCER gained the advantage early, went along under light rating two or three wide, was clear entering the stretch, then responded to stout left-handed urging to hold sway. JINNI broke a bit slow and came out bumping LEO'S PEGASUS, went up soon after to press the winner three or four wide, was just off FIERY DANCER much of the way but couldn't offer the needed response. ALMOST SPINNING (IRE) settled three wide early, raced between foes when rallying into the stretch and offered a mild gain. SHYTOE LAFEET, nicely position near the inside early, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch, angled three or four wide and came up empty. LEO'S PEGASUS, bumped after the break by JINNI, was well positioned between horses three or four wide into the stretch and flattened out. ITS JUST A DREAM tracked the pace four five wide to the stretch and came up empty. NOTTAWASAGA, four or five wide much of the way, failed to rally. OTHER LADY settled in behind horses and never reached serious contention. HALFKARAT began to tire leaving the backstretch.
