Footnotes

ST. HILDEGARD, never far back, raced under light rating, saved ground to the lane, worked her way out four wide for the drive, was forced out for a stride by TRICK BUSTER, then responded gamely in the drive to prevail. MAY NIGHT, within easy striking distance four or five wide, fanned seven or eight wide when straightened for the drive and was clearly best of the others. KIN TO THE WIND tracked the pace three abreast to the stretch, was prominent into the deep stretch but couldn't muster the needed response. TRICK BUSTER forced the pace from early on, gained a slight edge in the upper stretch, swerved out for a stride at the furlong grounds, then weakened. FINAL MELODY, in contention throughout and five wide for the drive, lacked a serious late challenge. GOTTAH PENNY was outrun to the lane and closed a late gap. RAIN SHOWER failed to rally in an even effort. STRONG VOWS bumped with PHILIPS PRIDE at the start, was outrun to the far turn, then failed to offer a closing kick. PHILIPS PRIDE bumped with STRONG VOWS at the break, gained the

advantage soon after, maneuvered near the inside, held on well until the upper stretch and faltered. ZULU QUEEN (IRE) hopped while breaking very slowly and never made an impact. GROUND HOG stalked the pace four or five wide, moved wider leaving the second turn and tired. CHA CHA BROWN tired leaving the backstretch.
