Footnotes

MUSEEB stalked the pace from the outset, raced three or four wide, gained a slight edge in the upper stretch, then gamely held FOREST PHANTOM safe while drifting out in the final stages and brushing that one. FOREST PHANTOM, outsprinted early, moved five wide entering the stretch, was brushed and floated out slightly wider by MUSEEB when that one drifted a bit, battled on even terms in the final sixteenth but was out-nodded. GO BUCKY GO, rank while gaining a clear advantage on the backstretch, made the pace to the upper stretch, weakened and dead-headed with MUSIC SCHOOL for third position. MUSIC SCHOOL, briefly in front after the start, settled just off front-running GO BUCKY GO, raced forwardly into the upper stretch, flattened out and dead-headed with GO BUCKY GO for third. BARBICAN bounced around in tight after the start, settled on the backstretch, came out seven wide concluding the turn and lacked a serious late challenge. BENNY THE BULL, jostled at the start, raced near the inside most of the way and had no closing kick. IMPECCABLE, within striking distance to the stretch and four or five wide, had no rally. ALPHA TEJANO raced between horses three or four wide to the stretch and came up empty. ANTRIM COUNTY, outrun from the start and four wide, came out ten wide leaving the turn but failed to make an impact. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF FOREST PHANTOM AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
