STAKES Lafayette S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added, of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 twice, 4 lbs.; a sweepstakes 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lafayette will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then those that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of four silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, March 28, 2007 with 32 nominations.

Seven Furlongs On The All Weather Track









Footnotes

CARNACKS CHOICE settled in behind rivals within easy striking distance early, was patiently ridden for a half, advanced five or six wide leaving the turn, then closed determinedly under urging to wear down CALL ME CLASH in a stiff drive. CALL ME CLASH went up to vie for the lead at once while four wide, dueled with DONTGETMADGETEVEN while outside that one, moved well clear into the lane, then had no mishap while unable to last. OLLIE JET, within easy striking distance always and four wide, was with the winner while inside that one entering the stretch and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. BARKLEY SOUND edged in three or four wide early, was outrun for a half, advanced between foes five wide into the lane and lacked a late account. PROM SHOES worked his way in four wide concluding the backstretch, continued near the inside around the turn and into the stretch, loomed prominently from the two path in the last eighth but came up empty. OUT OF GWEDDA, five or six wide most of the way, was asked about the five-sixteenths pole and failed to produce a significant late response. SILVER EXPRESS, sluggish to start and squeezed back, raced near the inside while outrun, was roused sharply about the five-sixteenths pole, swung out ten wide when straightened for the drive and improved position. IZZIE'S HALO, well placed inside early, inched up between foes on the turn, angled four or five wide into the upper stretch and was empty. STORM FORCE stalked the pace four wide to the stretch and tired. DONTGETMADGETEVEN went up to vie for the lead early while racing inside of CALL ME CLASH, remainder prominent until approaching the lane and tired. PLACE YOUR BET gave way on the turn.
