AL KHALI was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, wheeled out five wide entering the stretch, kicked on well and reeled in the leaders in the final yards. GUYS REWARD settled saving ground, shifted out and advanced between rivals, came four wide and forged command inside the furlong marker, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. CENTER DIVIDER pulled to contention along the inside, was bottled up leaving the second turn and into the lane, worked his way off of the inside but was left with too much to do. DARK COVE was forwardly placed three wide, drew even entering the stretch but lacked the needed late punch. AIR SUPPORT settled in hand four wide, moved up to make a mild bid with three-sixteenths to run but failed to sustain the drive. STORMY LORD opened clear to set the pace, was collared inside the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. DON CAVALLLO tracked the pace three wide, but came up empty between horses entering the stretch and faded.
