SWINGIN ON ICE, well in hand while saving ground from the outset, moved steadily along the rail to take over just before the eighth pole and increased her advantage under energetic urging. GULLEY, close up outside pacesetting LESLIE'S LADY from early on, moved boldly four wide entering the upper stretch, gained about even terms for the lead but couldn't match strides with SWINGIN ON ICE late. SWEEPING STORY, outsprinted for a half, made a mild bid to reach contention nearing the final furlong but lacked a further account. GOLDEN TEMPER followed the leaders in a contending position five or six wide early, came out further for the drive but failed to respond. CHELSIE'S HOUSE saved ground to no avail. STORMIN HANNA, well placed for a half while four wide, faded in the drive.
