**Footnotes**

HONOLUA STORM gained the lead early, raced in the three path, put away KIPPER VILLE approaching the stretch, edged clear while moving closer to the inner railing and continued under energetic handling to increase his advantage. KY DEPUTY, five or six wide most of the way, made a sweeping run entering the stretch, was just off the winner for the last eighth and couldn't threaten late as second best. ROGUE SCHOLAR, never far back, circled six or seven wide into the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but was empty. STREAMLINE, well placed three or four wide to the stretch, weakened gradually when straightened for the drive. SALUTE THE TROOPS moved inside on the turn, raced in contention throughout but was empty when the test came. KIPPER VILLE went up early to press the front-running winner three or four wide, raced in closest attendance to HONOLUA STORM until the final quarter and faltered. HIP HOP, bumped at the start, angled inside soon after, was outrun until the stretch and failed to menace while improving position. UNJUSTIFIED, near the inside throughout, failed to rally. SIR GULCH, in contention four wide for five furlongs, weakened gradually in the drive. DIXIELAND MAN drifted in at the start bumping HIP HOP, was checked, then failed to menace. MUDSLIDE, outrun throughout, was distanced. PINO ALTO swerved in badly soon after the start and unseated the rider.
