PLENTY COUPS vied for the early lead in hand, took over before a half, repulsed a bid by KING CARTER entering the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. ROCK IN BAGE (BRZ) forwardly placed off the rail, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be up for the place. KING CARTER close up while off the rail, made a run at the winner approaching the stretch, held on well to the final furlong and tired. CAJUN PRIZE reserved off the inside, lacked a closing bid. SEISMIC FORCE outrun early in the two path, could not menace. I AM AWESOME within striking distance in the three path, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. MEMORIAL MANIAC was outrun. MORAL FIBER contested the early pace inside and stopped.
