NEW BELIEVER reserved early, angled out four wide late on the turn when rallying and closed well to be clear late. GOLDEN WEEKEND vied for the early lead off the inside, took over on the turn, led the field into deep stretch but was outfinished. ESCROW forwardly placed from the start, tracked the winner three wide with three furlongs to go, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. JOCKEY RIDGE close up four wide, weakened. FORT APACHE STAR far back for a half, angled out for the drive and closed a late gap. HAIL TO SHILOH within striking distance, raced four wide past the three furlong marker and tired. POLITICAL NONSENSE rushed inside after a sluggish beginning, vied for the lead into the turn, held on well to the stretch and faded.
