SMARTEN DESTINY set the pace near the rail, angled out for the drive, repulsed a bid by JADE'S REVENGE in midstretch and edged clear. VALTRUS forwardly placed off the rail, lacked room briefly behind the winner in upper stretch, moved to the rail with a furlong to to but lodged only a mild bid for the place. JADE'S REVENGE within striking distance off the rail, moved out to advance three wide on the second turn, made a run at the winner in midstretch but weakened slightly late. I COME FROM BEHIND pressed the pace off the inside and held on gamely. GREYCLIFF EXCHANGE reserved off the rail, moved closer between rivals late on the second turn, angled out for a clear path with a furlong to go but had no late bid. DOUBLE PITTSBURGH within striking distance three wide, moved out a path approaching the stretch but lacked a rally.
