Footnotes

HENNY'S HURRICANE attended the pace along the inside, split rivals entering the stretch, quickly kicked clear and widened through the drive. HUNT FOR COLLEEN was unhurried into stride, closed the gap through the turn, came seven wide between horses and finished willingly to earn the place. HIP contended between horses, loomed a danger five wide entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. CLASS OF FIFTY TWO hopped at the start, moved up along the inside, angled out leaving the turn and improved position. GREY MIST lagged well back, swung eight wide and finished with a belated gain. COME A CALLIN stalked the pace four wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. QUITE EXPLOSIVE was allowed to settle, came six wide but lacked a response when called upon. BASILIO'S THUNDER made a middle move five wide, offered a mild bid but came up empty entering the stretch. DANCING DARCEY was forwardly placed along the inside through the turn and faded. TOUCH OF SUCCESS was close up between horses for a half and dropped out. HI HO EURO pulled clear to set the pace well off of the inside, angled to the inside entering the turn, was headed inside the five-sixteenths pole, stopped and was eased to the wire but walked off.
