FULL MANDATE, never far back while following the pace three or four wide, inched after front-running PLAY IT OUT nearing the stretch and closed determinedly under strong right-handed encouragement to wear that one down in the final stages. PLAY IT OUT gained the lead early, edged clear on the first turn, went along under careful handling and couldn't last in a game try. QUEST, close up inside from the outset, loomed prominently from the rail through the drive but wasn't quite good enough. M B SEA, sluggish to begin, was allowed to settle, commenced a sweeping run four or five wide leaving the half-mile ground, reached prominence when straightened for the drive but could not sustain the needed momentum. SHIP SHAPE, three or four wide most of the way, failed to rally. REAL LIFE drifted in at the start, tracked the pace in a striking position four wide for six furlongs and weakened. BATTLEDAR maneuvered in three or four wide early, remained in contention for three-quarters and failed to respond. MAJESTIC THIEF broke in the air and was outrun.
